Funding: a grant

- The Sultanate of Oman offers 20 million USD for a Cultural Centre in Beirut
- Agreement signed and funds transferred
- Grant to cover construction and equipment
- Lebanon to provide land and operating budget

Terms of the Agreement

Sultanate of Oman and Ministry of Culture select jointly:

- Parcel for construction in Central Beirut
- Engineering company for the construction (Khatib & Alami)
- Consulting company for the conception
